Parents/Guardians/Custodians,

Morgan County Schools will continue to utilize the Kentucky Department of Public Health's Covid-19 Mode of Instruction Metrics for K-12 Education as guidance to determine the mode of instruction from week-to-week. Though the guidance has been adjusted, Morgan County Schools will continue to assess the current incidence rate along with specific incidents related directly to the district to determine the mode of instruction. The following decision will be announced on Friday of each week using data reported from the Governor's Office on Thursday following the outline below:

- Morgan County Schools will utilize the hybrid model and the A/B rotation if the incidence rate is Green or Yellow.
- Morgan County Schools will utilize the hybrid model and the A/B rotation if the incidence rate is Orange and the incidence rate is not a direct result of cases from the district.
- Morgan County Schools will utilize the Learning at Home platform for all students if the incidence rate is Red.

Once the COVID-19 Vaccine has been administered to staff, Morgan County Schools will transition to the hybrid model and the A/B rotation regardless of the incidence rate given that it is not a direct result of cases from the district. If the district's incidence rate increases to a level that is deemed unsafe to have the A/B rotation, then the district will move to the Learning at Home platform.
