Morgan County Schools COVID-19 Operations Plan

Masking

Morgan County Schools will remain mask optional for students, staff, and guests. Masking will NOT be required on grounds, in buildings, or on buses.

COVID-19 Protocol

- Test to Stay will no longer be available at the Morgan County Board of Education.
- If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, they should stay home until symptoms begin to improve and the individual has been free of a fever (without any fever reducing medicines) for the past 24 hours. A negative test or documentation, is not required to return to school for students or staff members.
- ◆ The district will not be doing any contact tracing, nor requiring quarantines for anyone exposed to COVID-19. Siblings who do not have symptoms should be in attendance.
- Athletes who have tested positive must still complete the KHSAA Return to Play process before returning for athletic practice and competition. See the school athletic director or visit the website below for more details.
