Morgan County High School is located in Morgan County, KY and serves as the only high school in Morgan County. Our high school sits in West Liberty, the county seat. According to the most recent data, the population of Morgan County was 13,923. The median household income was \$29,707 in comparison to the state average of \$41,141. 33.9% of households live below the poverty line. Only 72.7% of residents have a high school diploma with an average of 11.8% having a Bachelor's degree or higher. Morgan County High School has a student population of approximately 615 students in grades 9-12. We are currently housed in a facility that is over 40 years old without many modern conveniences. Currently, we are in the construction process of a State of the Art facility that is scheduled to open in April of 2019. Our school employs 40 certified staff member and 23 classified staff members. Our student attendance rate averages 93%. and our 4 year cohort adjusted graduation rate is currently 93.7%. Our student population is predominately Caucasian with a minority of less than 1 percent. We have 73% of students who qualify for Free/ Reduced lunch. With the high number of students who live below the poverty line, we do face challenges in deterring students from dropping out of school due to financial issues at home or academic challenges. We strive constantly to motivate and support our student population.
